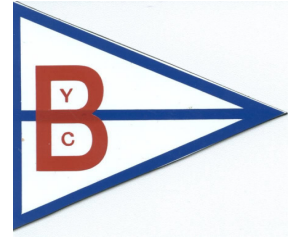


**Beachwood Yacht Club  
2018 Annual Fall Series  
September 9, 16, 23, and 30th**



## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Class Rules except as altered by sailing instructions will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) Rule 30.1 shall apply. I Flag will not be displayed. Races will start by a dinghy starting sequence: Three minutes, two minutes, one minute, thirty seconds, twenty seconds, ten seconds, 5,4,3,2,1 starting horn. This changes Appendix S. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.4 The Beachwood Yacht Club (BYC) reserves the right to change this NOR and the Registration Instructions by amendment posted on the BYC Notice Board. In the event of a conflict between the NOR and Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions posted on the BYC Notice Board will prevail.

### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist (Green, Red, White and Blue), Sunfish, Sunfish Green, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Club 420, Flying Scot, M-Scows, Ensign. We can accommodate additional Fleets. Three boats will constitute a fleet.
- 2.2 Optimist Fleet. The following are the requirements for each fleet as established by USODA (ages apply as to the first day of Regatta).
  - a. Red Fleet: 13, 14, 15 years old
  - b. Blue Fleet: 11, 12 years old
  - c. White Fleet 10 years old or under
  - d. Green Fleet:
    1. Skippers must be age 15 or under on December 31<sup>st</sup> of the current year
    2. Upon winning three or more green fleet trophies in either 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place or any combination there of, a skipper shall advance to his/her appropriate age group fleet.
    3. Skippers may not previously have raced outside of green fleet (i.e. in red, blue, white or similar advanced fleet), except for participation in red, white, blue or similar advanced fleet at which no green fleet was offered shall not prevent a sailor from returning to and racing in green fleet, provided the sailor continues to meet other green fleet eligibility criteria.

2.3 Registration will start at 9:45 am the day of the race.

### **3 FEES**

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

Series: Boat and Skipper \$35.00, per crew 12.00

Daily: Boat and Skipper \$15.00, per crew \$5.00

### **4 SCHEDULE**

4.1 Registration and Check In:

From 9:45 am day of the race

4.2 Skipper's Meeting:

11:45P.M. day of race

4.3 Racing Warning Signal 1:00 P.M.

(No race will begin after 3 pm except at the discretion of the Regatta Chair.)

4.4 Number of races:

The race committee will make every attempt to complete 3 races per day for a series of 12 races to complete the Fall Series.

4.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1:00 P.M.

### **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after 9:00 A.M. on Sept. 9, 2018 at Beachwood Yacht Club or on line at [www.beachwoodyachtclub.com](http://www.beachwoodyachtclub.com).

### **6 VENUE**

6.1 The regatta will be held at Beachwood Yacht Club, Compass Avenue, Beachwood, NJ 08722.

6.2 Attachment A shows the location of the racing areas.

### **7 THE COURSES**

7.1 The diagram in Attachment A shows the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate course length will be one nautical mile.

7.2 Two to three courses will be run. Course 1: Combined Opti's and Course 2: Lasers, Club 420's, Sunfish, Ensigns, and other. A third course may be added as needed.

### **8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

8.1 For all classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

8.2 Decisions of the Protest Committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

### **9 SCORING**

9.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low point systems.

9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute the series.

No rain date for days of the Fall Series.

9.3 (a) When nine or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will include all races scored.

(b) When from ten through twelve races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her best nine race scores.

(c) All scores will be final ½ hour after posting

## 10 PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded for each of the fleets based on the number of qualifiers in accordance with the following rules:

a. A minimum of 9 races must be completed in order to qualify. In the event that there are less than 9 races, all races must be completed in order to qualify.

a. A minimum of three (3) boats must qualify for a fleet to receive awards.

b. In addition to overall trophies, the Opti Fleet trophies will also be awarded based on the number of qualifiers, for Red, Blue, White, and Green Fleets. (Green Fleet is not included in the Opti Overall)

d. Keeper Trophies:

<sup>35</sup>/<sub>17</sub> First Place: All classes which qualify.

<sup>35</sup>/<sub>17</sub> Second Place: From four (4) to eight (8) qualifiers

<sup>35</sup>/<sub>17</sub> Third Place: From nine (9) to fifteen (15) qualifiers

<sup>35</sup>/<sub>17</sub> Fourth Place: From sixteen (16) to twenty-two (22) qualifiers

<sup>35</sup>/<sub>17</sub> Fifth Place: Greater than twenty-six (22) qualifiers.

\* All qualified skippers not receiving a trophy will receive a qualifier award.

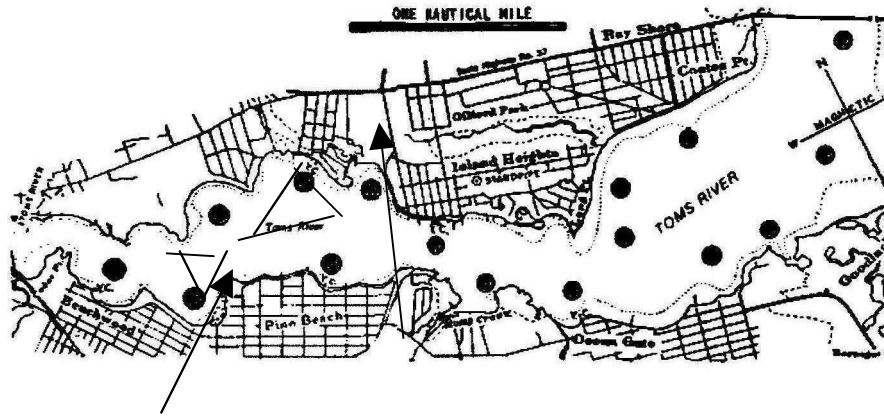
## 11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY
